THE TEACHER WILL:

Introduce the dotted quarter note

Introduce the flat and how it changes the natural pitch of a given note

Introduce the Key of F Major and point out the flat in the key signature for all but trumpet

Introduce the Key of G Major to trumpet

Introduce fingering for D to the trumpet

Introduce some of the more well-known mariachi ensembles including **Mariachi Sol (Sun) de Mexico**, **Mariachi Cobre** (Copper), and **Mariachi Los Camperos** (The Country Ones).

THE STUDENT WILL:

Play the dotted quarter note rhythm

Demonstrate understanding the flat and how it changes the natural pitch of a given note

Play in the Key of F Major-strings

Play the Key of G Major-trumpet

Play D-trumpet

Sing and play *Por El Camino*
